## **Hebrews 4:14-16**


**14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.**

# **There Is “Sympathetic” Understanding**

## Hebrews 4:15

**15 For we do not have a High Priest Who is unable to understand and sympathize and have a shared feeling with our weaknesses and infirmities and liability to the assaults of temptation, but One Who has been tempted in every respect as we are, yet without sinning.**

## **Romans 8:3, Galatians 5:19-21**

**The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So God did what the law could not do. He sent his own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins.**

**When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division, envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these.**

## **John 5:19, 12:49**

**5:19** So Jesus explained, “I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself. He does only what he sees the Father doing. Whatever the Father does, the Son also does.”

**12:49** I don't speak on my own authority. The Father who sent me has commanded me what to say and how to say it.

## **Matthew 26:39**

**39** He went on a little farther and bowed with his face to the ground, praying, “My Father! If it is possible, let this cup of suffering be taken away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine.”



## Hebrews 2:17-18

**17 Therefore, it was necessary for him to be made in every respect like us, his brothers and sisters, so that he could be our merciful and faithful High Priest before God. Then he could offer a sacrifice that would take away the sins of the people. [NLT]**

**18 For because He Himself [in His humanity] has suffered in being tempted (tested and tried), He is able [immediately] to run to the cry of (assist, relieve) those who are being tempted and tested and tried [and who therefore are being exposed to suffering]. [AMP]**

## Hebrews 4:16

**16 Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy for our failures... [AMP]**

## **Romans 8:1**

**There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus**

## **1 John 3:20-22a**

**20 For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.**

**21-22 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God. And whatever we ask we receive from Him...**

**1 John 1:9**

**9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

**Hebrews 9:14**

**14 Just think how much more the blood of Christ will purify our consciences from sinful deeds so that we can worship the living God.**

**16 So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.**

## **Romans 8:1-2**

**1 So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus.**

**2 And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.**

## **Galatians 5:16**

**16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.**



### **Ephesians 3:16**

**16 I pray that from his glorious, unlimited resources he will empower you with inner strength through his Spirit.**

### **Colossians 1:11**

**11 We also pray that you will be strengthened with all his glorious power so you will have all the endurance and patience you need. May you be filled with joy**

## **Ephesians 1:17-19**

**17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,**

**18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,**

**19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe**
