## **Psalm 139:7-10**

- 7 Where can I go from Your Spirit?  
Or where can I flee from Your presence?**
- 8 If I ascend into heaven, You are there;  
If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there.**
- 9 If I take the wings of the morning,  
And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,**
- 10 Even there Your hand shall lead me,  
And Your right hand shall hold me.**

## **Romans 8:35-37**

**35 Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death?**

**36 As it is written:**

**“For Your sake we are killed all day long;  
We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.”**

**37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.**

## **Romans 8:38-39**

**For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.**

## Romans 14:4

**4 Who are you to pass judgment on and censure another's household servant? It is before his own master that he stands or falls. And he shall stand and be upheld, for the Master (the Lord) is mighty to support him and make him stand. [AMP]**

**4 Do you have any business crossing people off the guest list or interfering with God's welcome? If there are corrections to be made or manners to be learned, God can handle that without your help. [Message]**



## **2 Timothy 4:16-18**

**16 The first time I was brought before the judge, no one came with me. Everyone abandoned me. May it not be counted against them.**

**17 But the Lord stood with me and gave me strength so that I might preach the Good News in its entirety for all the Gentiles to hear. And he rescued me from certain death.**

**18 Yes, and the Lord will deliver me from every evil attack and will bring me safely into his heavenly Kingdom. All glory to God forever and ever! Amen.**

## **Romans 2:3-4**

**3 And do you think this, O man, you who judge those practicing such things, and doing the same, that you will escape the judgment of God?**

**4 Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?**

## **Luke 15:4-5**

**4 “If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won’t he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it?**

**5 And when he has found it, he will joyfully carry it home on his shoulders.**

## Revelation 3:20

**20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.**

**20 Behold, I'm standing at the door, knocking. If your heart is open to hear my voice and you open the door within, I will come in to you and feast with you, and you will feast with me. [TPT]**

## **Luke 15:20-22**

**20 “So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him.**

**21 His son said to him, ‘Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.’**

**22 “But his father said to the servants, ‘Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger and sandals for his feet.**

## **Luke 15:23-24**

**23 And kill the calf we have been fattening. We must celebrate with a feast,**

**24 for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found.’ So the party began.**

## **2 Corinthians 7:9-11**

**9 Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing.**

**10 For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.**

**11 For observe this very thing, that you sorrowed in a godly manner: What diligence it produced in you, what clearing of yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what vehement desire, what zeal, what vindication! In all things you proved yourselves to be clear in this matter.**
